Meat My Grill!

Ages 11-18 (as of Sept. 1, 2021)

May 31 - June 3, 2022 ● 10:00 AM - 3:30 PM

Youth ages 11 -18 (as of Sept. 1, 2021) will learn how to safely master the grill this summer! This fun-filled day camp will provide youth with important life skills such as grilling safety, responsibility, and food prep. From grilling steaks to pork chops, youth have the opportunity to grill, eat and even compete! Space is limited. Scholarships are available. Youth will need to bring their own lunch daily.
